In continuation to the Ministry's letter of even No. dated 30.04.2015 wherein a Letter of Intent was issued to the Society with respect to the proposal submitted to the Central Government as cited above, I am directed to say that after careful consideration of the recommendations of the CCIM in terms of criteria as specified in the Regulations 3 and 10 of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013, provisions under the IMCC Act, 1970, relevant regulations made there under and as per approval of the Hon'ble MoS (IC), Ministry of AYUSH for the UG/PG course(s) for grant of conditional permission for the academic session 2015-16 vide Ministry's letter No.R.11011/01/2015-EP (IM-1) dated 05.05.2015 (available on Ministry's website <indianmedicine.nic.in>); permission of the Central Government is hereby granted to establish a new Ayurveda Medical College titled as “Yashwantrao Chavan Ayurvedic Medical College and Hospital.” Aurangabad, Maharashtra with intake capacity of 100 seats in BAMS course from the session 2015-16 under the provisions of the section 13A of the IMCC Act, 1970. Therefore, the college may take admissions for the academic session 2015-16 subject to the condition that the following requirement should be fulfilled by the college positively by the 31st December, 2015:

- (i) Relevant provisions of the Minimum Standards Requirements of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 and Regulation 10 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standard Requirements of Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospital) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 by 31st December 2015, to get conditional permission for the session 2016-17.
 - (ii) Relevant requirements under the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) (Amendment) Regulations, 2012 read with amendment Regulations of 2013 (for UG Ayurveda).
2. The University administration will ensure that sufficient qualified teachers and non-teaching staff in the college and requisite staff in the hospital, as per the relevant CCIM Regulations, are in position before the admission of the first batch of students in the 1st professional of BAMS course is made, under intimation to the Central Government and CCIM.
 3. The college has to develop the requisite infrastructure for IInd, IIIrd and IVth professionals well in time as per the CCIM norms which will be verified and reported by the CCIM at least three months before the start of next professional and accordingly, the permission for taking admissions in subsequent academic session will be issued.
 4. The college administration may take up the matter for recognition of the qualification under section 14(2) of the IMCC Act, 1970 at that time when the first batch of students admitted against this course appears for the first final professional examination of the said course.
 5. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
